KA2BED, President, called the meeting of the ARAST General Membership to order on August 20, 2015, at 7:10 pm. The meeting took place at the Horseheads Town and Country Fire Department, 130 Gardner Road, Horseheads, New York.

The secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting. After a small correction the minutes were approved as read and will be posted on the website as soon as possible.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Given by N2AMW. A motion was made second and approved to accept the report.

<u>Repeater Report</u> – N2EUS – The repeaters are working well. The County inadvertently dug up the phone lines and Verizon will not be asked to fix them. N2EUS has cancelled our contract with Verizon and is moving ahead with Consumer Cellular which will save us money and provide better service.

A new club chartered by Meade Murtland, John Domville and others are working at getting Buzz's repeater up and running. This repeater is the 444.2 and will be up and running at a new site.

N2EUS has a polyphaser to put up on the 70/10 machine to help with the Barrel Rolls.

KA2BED reported on Echolink – it was down due to a bad end on a dB9 serial cable. It has been fixed and is up and running again.

<u>Membership Committee</u> – KD2DGF reported that the membership list on the website is almost up to date. There are three people currently not on the list they will be added As soon as possible.

<u>Education Report</u> –KA2BED – The following classes and scheduled times were noted: Technician class Tuesdays in September, General Class – Thursdays in September – Both will be conducted at the Petrie Room, Lower Level Arnot Ogden Memorial Hospital, 7pm. Books will be available at a cost of \$30. Charlie will order books at the first class to give out the second.

The test for both will be given at the Hamfest in September.

<u>Hamfest Report</u>- KD2DGF- Tickets are ready for sale and will be available at Tropical Fish Outlet and the Grand Spectacle. Vendors have been sent information – Quick Silver has reserved 14 tables, Gene from KJI has responded that he will be attending as well. Larry will be running the kitchen and getting the door prizes together as well.

The next Hamfest meetings will be September 10 (Horseheads Masonic Lodge) and 17 (T&CFD). 7pm.

N2AMW still needs to purchase 5 more door prizes – he discussed buying the basic hand held radios such as the Baofeng. He also is looking at the rebates that are available. N2EUS suggested getting a dual band base antenna or two for door prizes.

Kay Norton will be the contact person at the Soaring Museum for this event. She will hold a meeting soon. KA2BED also stated that he is learning how to use the new Echo Producer software. He will be testing it on the echolink system.

KC3DOV asked questions regarding the Website and the listing of the email addresses, mailing addresses and phone numbers. She will work with KD2DGF to obtain the information.

New Business:

A motion was made seconded and approved to hold a drawing for two tickets to next year's fest. This will be drawn based upon those who have paid to renew their dues by the end of the fest on September 26. The Drawing will be held at the October ARAST Meeting. KA2BED stated that he will include two tickets to the Winterfest as well.
